BRIDGES Updates: 'Make-Up?' Check Box Added to Service Log

Sept. 3, 2025

BRIDGES prevents service logs from exceeding the planned length of time allowed on planned services.

Example: Sally is authorized to provide family training/counseling (special instruction) four times per month for one hour. Sally cannot enter a service note for a visit that lasts longer than one hour.

In the past, if Sally needed to make up a missed visit, she would have to add a second service note to capture the make-up visit time.

The BRIDGES service log now has a "Make-Up?" check box that can be selected for providers to enter the full time in one service note. For instance, Sally missed a visit last week because she was sick. The family wants Sally to make up the missed visit over the next two weeks by extending each session by 30 minutes. With this new functionality, Sally can enter one service note for 1.5 hours for the regular visit and the 30-minute make-up session.
