


Unallowable Costs & Funding Limitations

- Direct patient care services (except as specifically permitted)
- Construction of new buildings or major renovations
- Land or real estate purchases
- Lobbying or political activities
- Incentive payments, promotional giveaways, or cash prizes
- Costs reimbursed by other federal programs (no double dipping)
- Entertainment, alcohol, or personal expenses

- Renovations limited to minor alterations only
- Equipment purchases must be directly tied to program goals
- Administrative/indirect costs capped at federally negotiated rates
- Workforce payments allowed only for recruitment, retention, and training, not ongoing salaries outside scope
- Technology investments must align with healthcare delivery, telehealth, data security, or interoperability
- States must avoid duplication with existing federal/state programs and demonstrate complementarity




South Carolina intends to utilize the RHTP to scale established and successful models




SC Highlighted Use of Funds Categories










